Cardiomyopathies in the Dog and Cat

During the first hour of the program, we will discuss the most common cardiomyopathy seen in dogs: a dilated cardiomyopathy (DCM) phenotype. The second hour of the program will focus on the most common cardiomyopathy seen in cats: a hypertrophic cardiomyopathy (HCM) phenotype. We will discuss primary vs. secondary HCM in cats as well as treatment and prognosis.
